... to *Österlen's Haflinger Horse-riding*. And also welcome to our, the Hüllert-Åkesson family's, farm with its rippling creek, cobble stoned courtyard and breathtaking view of the ocean and the famous rolling hills of Brösarp – “Brösarps backar”.

In a slow pace, in groups of seven people at the most, we ride through diverse surroundings through the woods, open scenery and/or down to the ocean - sometimes in trot as well. Less experienced riders are also welcome!

We Are Here!

Österlen's Haflinger Horse-riding is located in Skåne, in the south of Sweden, on Österlen, 6 km north of the village of Kivik and 2 km south of the village of Brösarp along Road no 9 (Riksväg 9).

The Haflinger Horse

The original Haflinger horse, the ancestor of today's Haflinger, is a small mountain horse that has existed in the Southern Tyrol in Italy for centuries. They were primarily used for farming, forestry and as pack horses.

The breeding of the Haflinger today aims at getting a versatile and all-round family horse for leisure riding. They vary in size ranging from 135 to 150 cm. The Haflinger horse is calm and has an easygoing nature, yet being full of energy and eager to work.

The Haflinger horses are always bright bay coloured with a white mane and tail, and they have a lovely temperament!

The Horse Rides

- **The Riding Walk**
 - A. 500 SEK (2 h ride incl coffee and sandwich)**
 - B. 850 SEK (3 h ride incl coffee and sandwich)**
 - C. 1.000 SEK (3 h ride incl lunch buffet)**

You brush, groom and get to know “your” horse before saddling up. We mount our horses in the riding paddock, where we also make the last adjustments before heading out for a scenic ride at a slow pace. One, or two, experienced riders/instructors will accompany the group at all times. Some experience of horse riding is required.

- **Try-to-ride** **350 SEK (1,5 h - riding half of the time)**

For those who want to evoke an interest in horses, this is a chance to try what it is all about – you get to brush and groom the horse, saddle up and ride at ease in the paddock. Supervision is provided by an experienced rider/instructor.

These can be arranged for those who want to enjoy the rolling hills and the scenic landscape from the horseback as well as indulge in a tasty lunch or barbecue buffet outdoors.

You are welcome to rent our flat/house when it is not being used in the daily riding activities. It sleeps 8 people, has a fully equipped kitchen and a sitting room/lounge area with a TV and fireplace.
